






Apprentices by Gender by Industry




Apprentices by Ethnicity by Industry



Apprentices by Education Level by Industry





Apprentice Veteran and Disability Status by Industry



Age at Program Start - Automotive









Age at Program Start - Manufacturing















Age at Program Start - Healthcare








Age at Program Start – Social & Human Services


