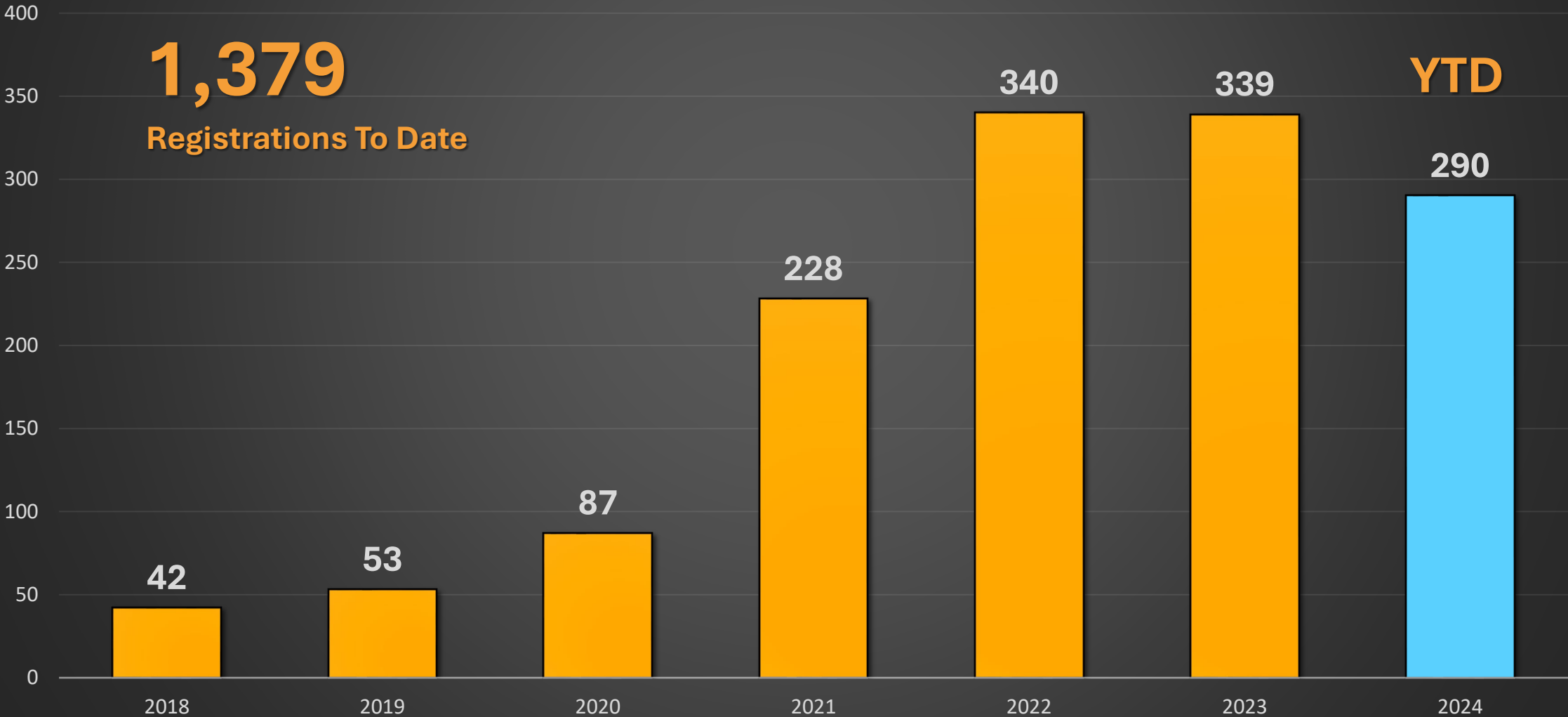

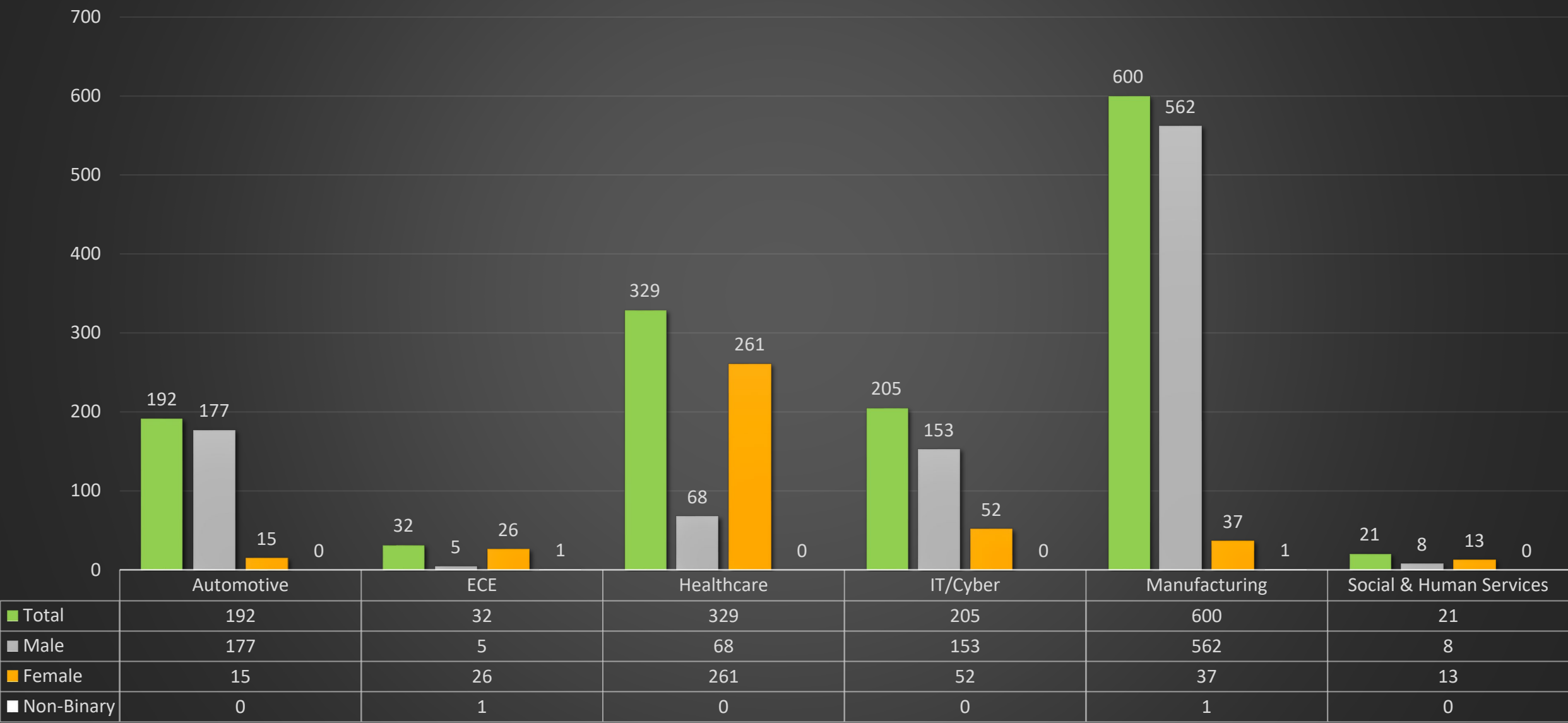

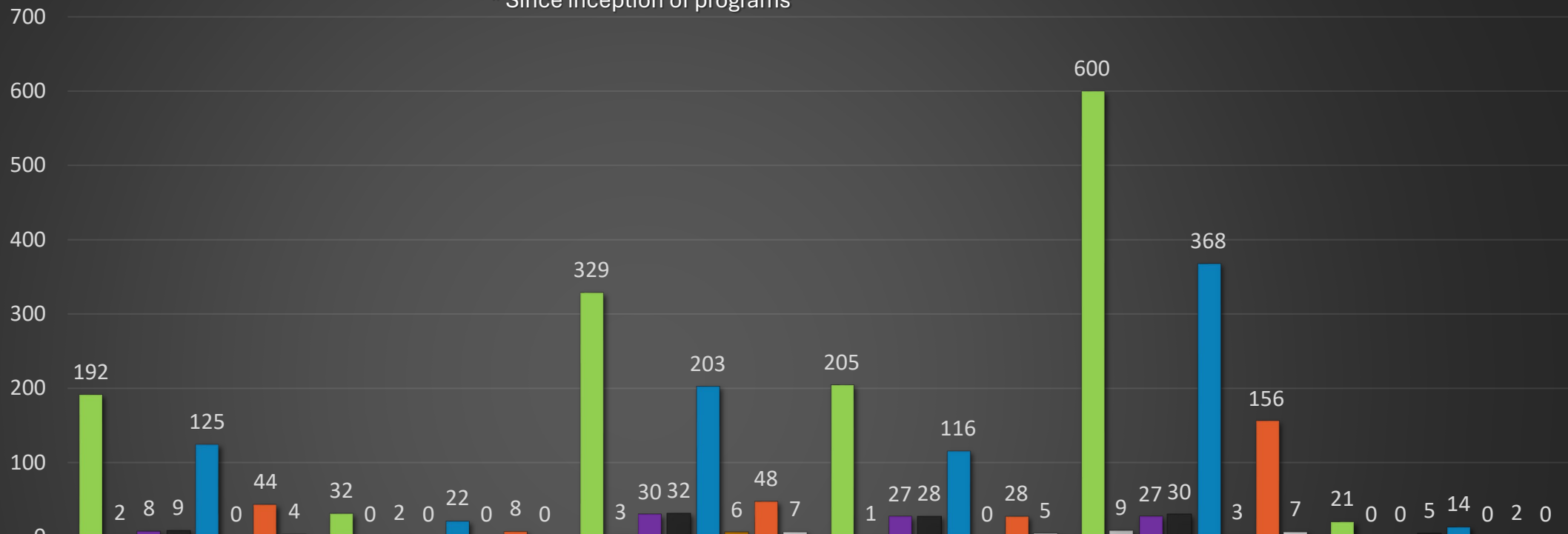
Apprentices by Gender by Industry

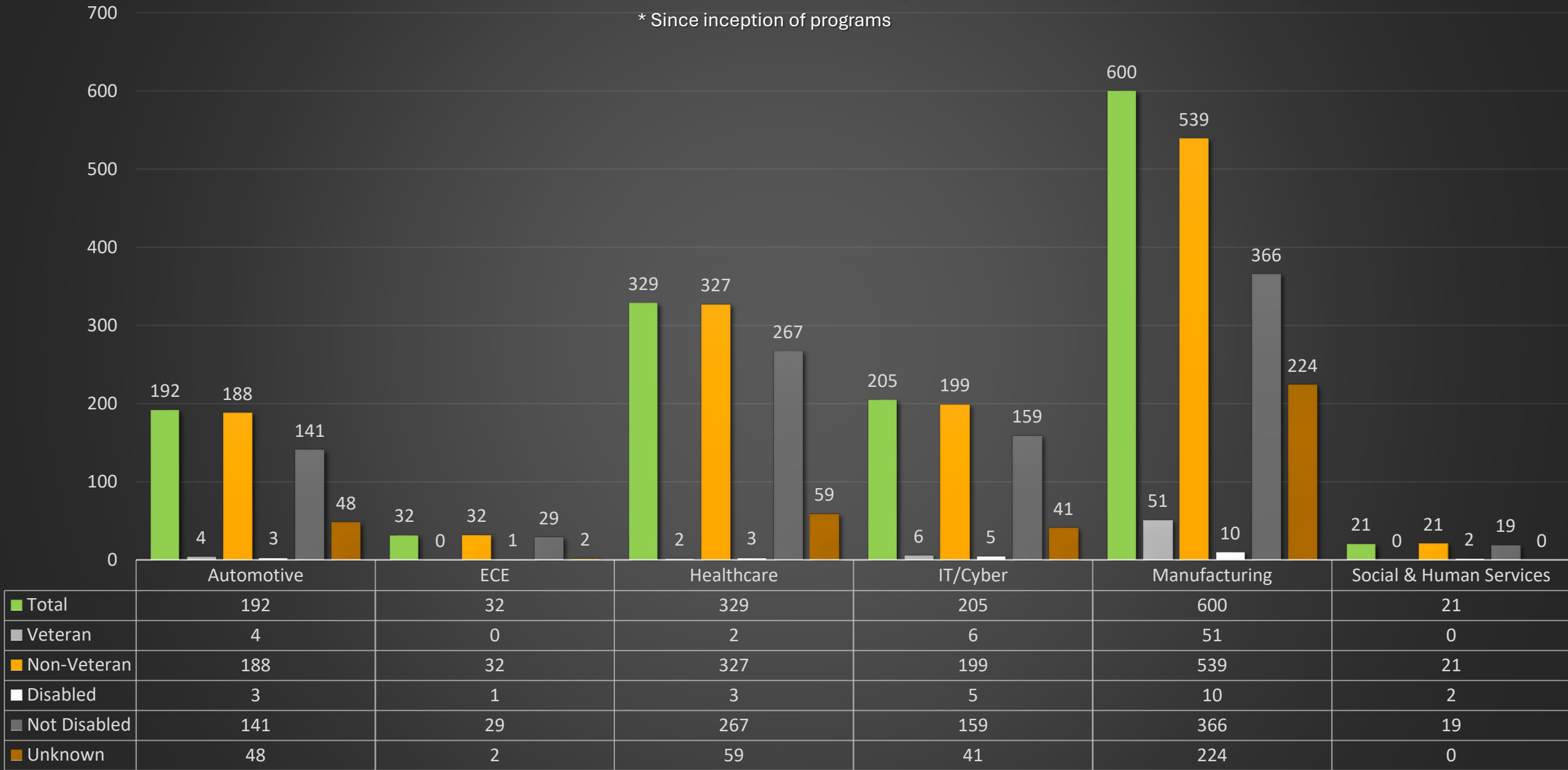

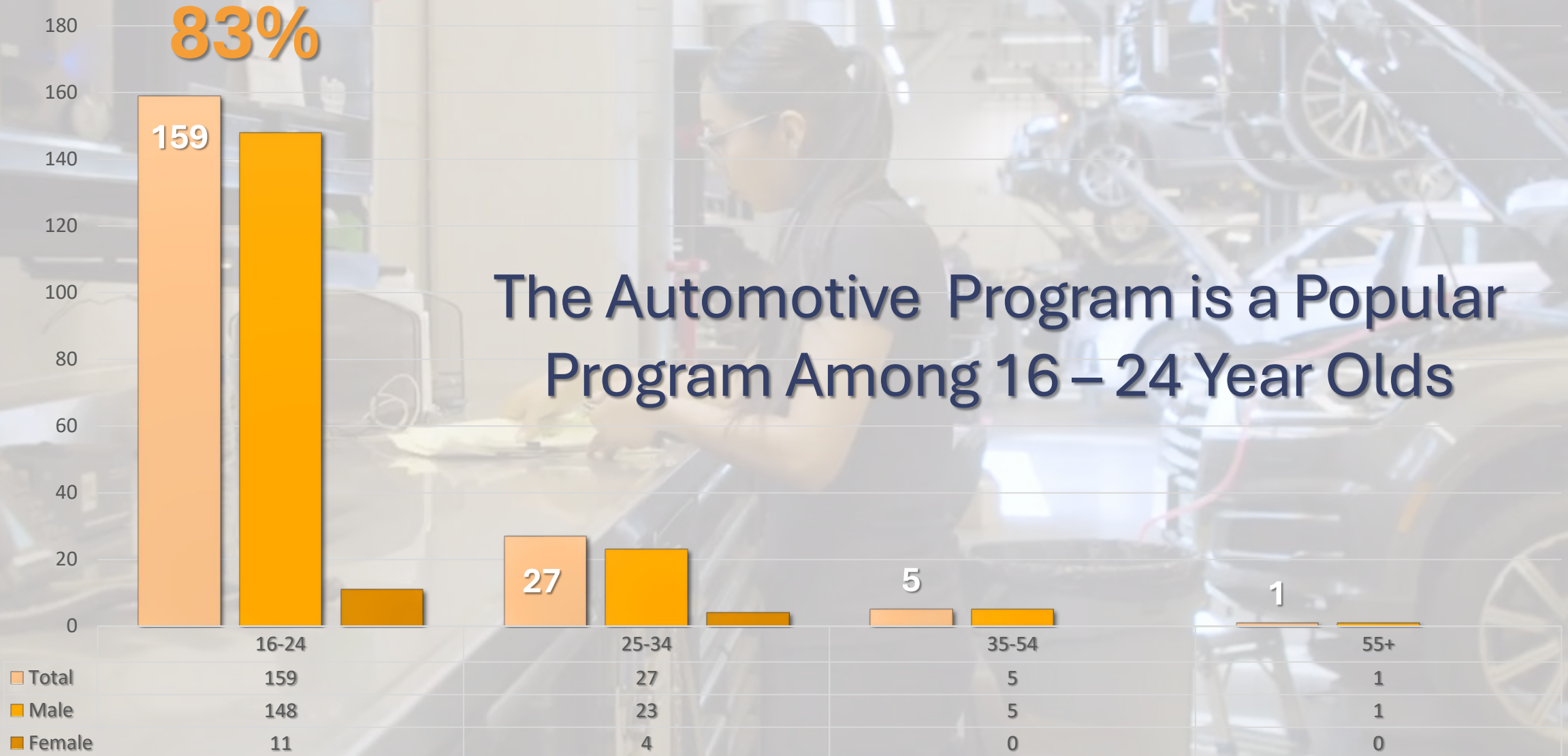
Apprentice Veteran and Disability Status by Industry

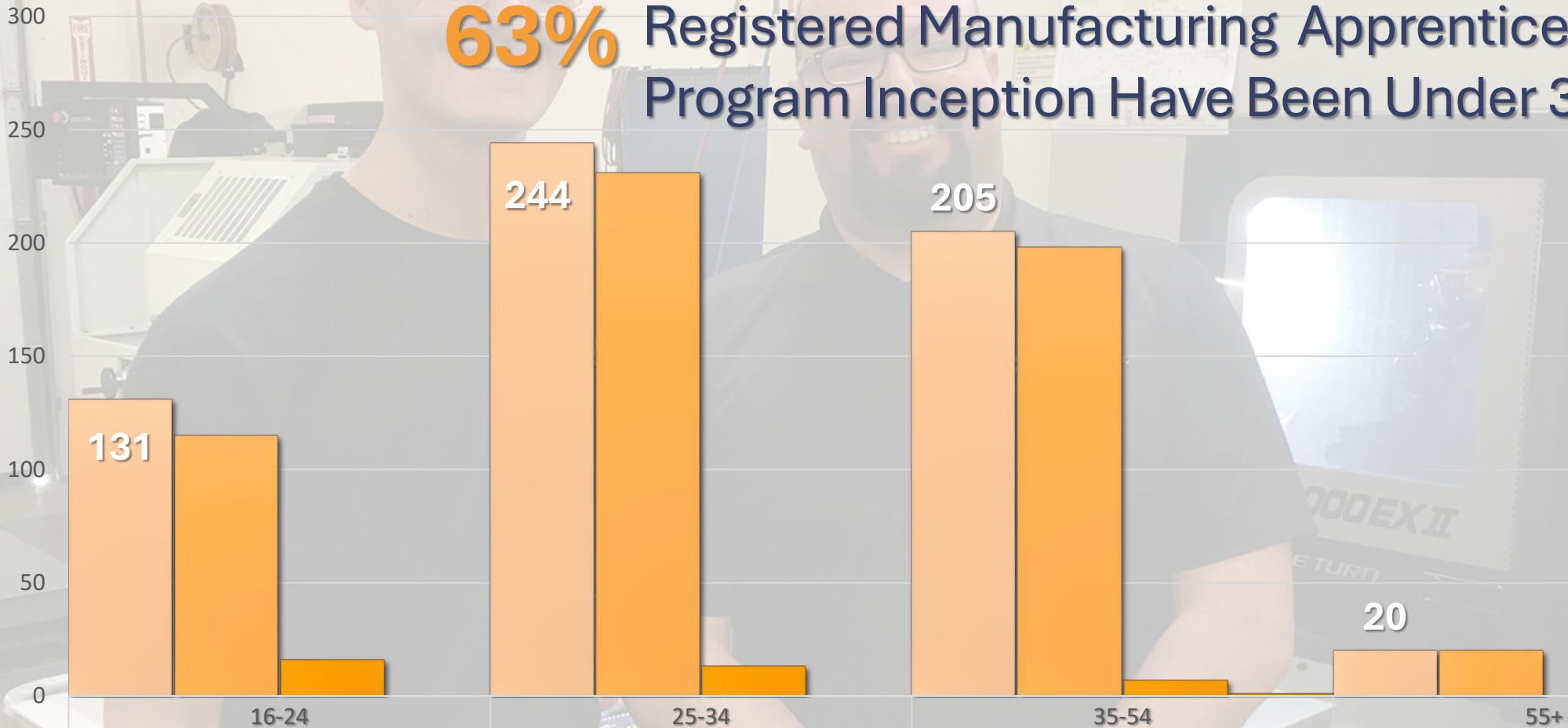


Age at Program Start - Manufacturing

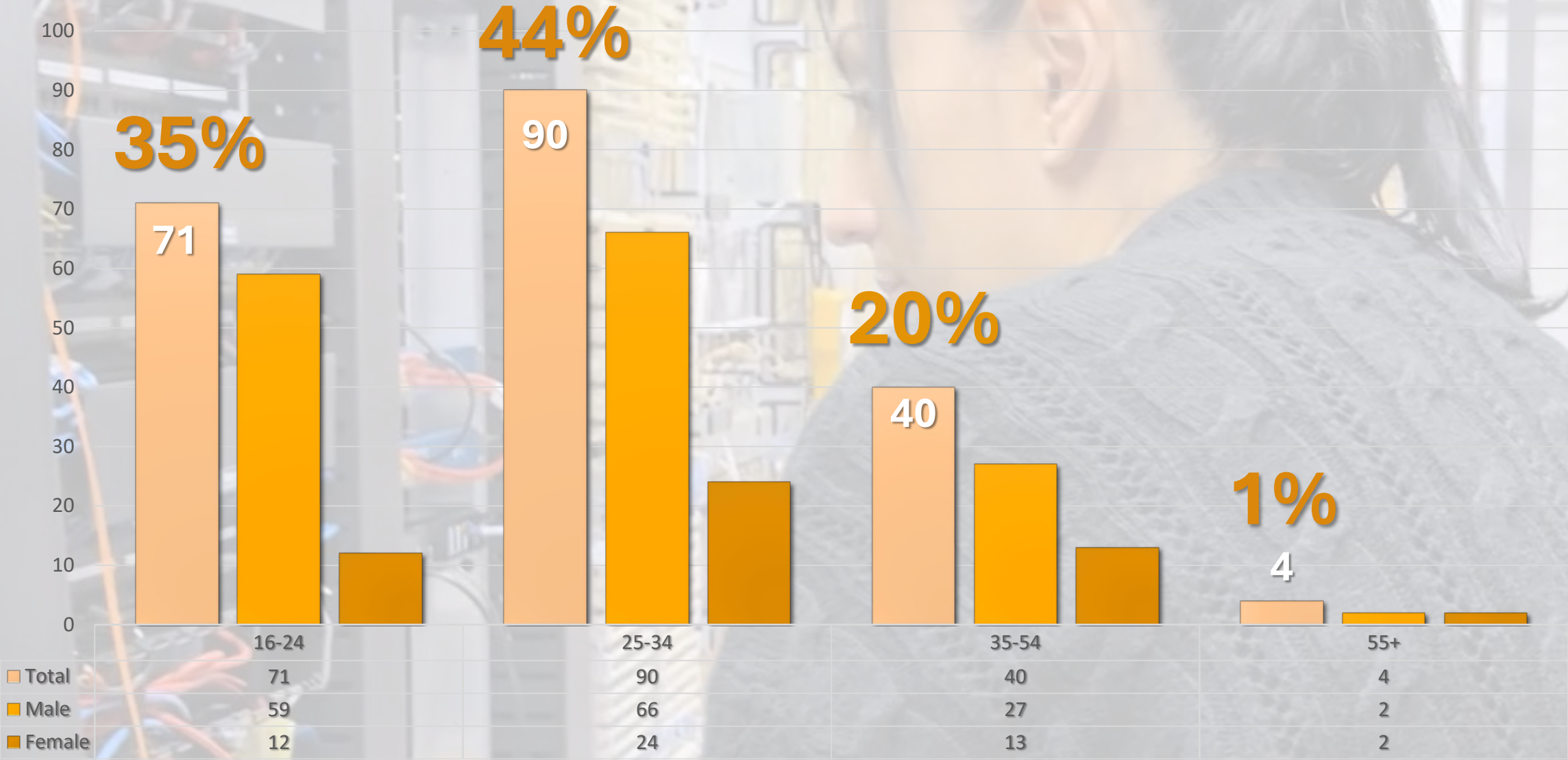

Age at Program Start – IT/ Cybersecurity



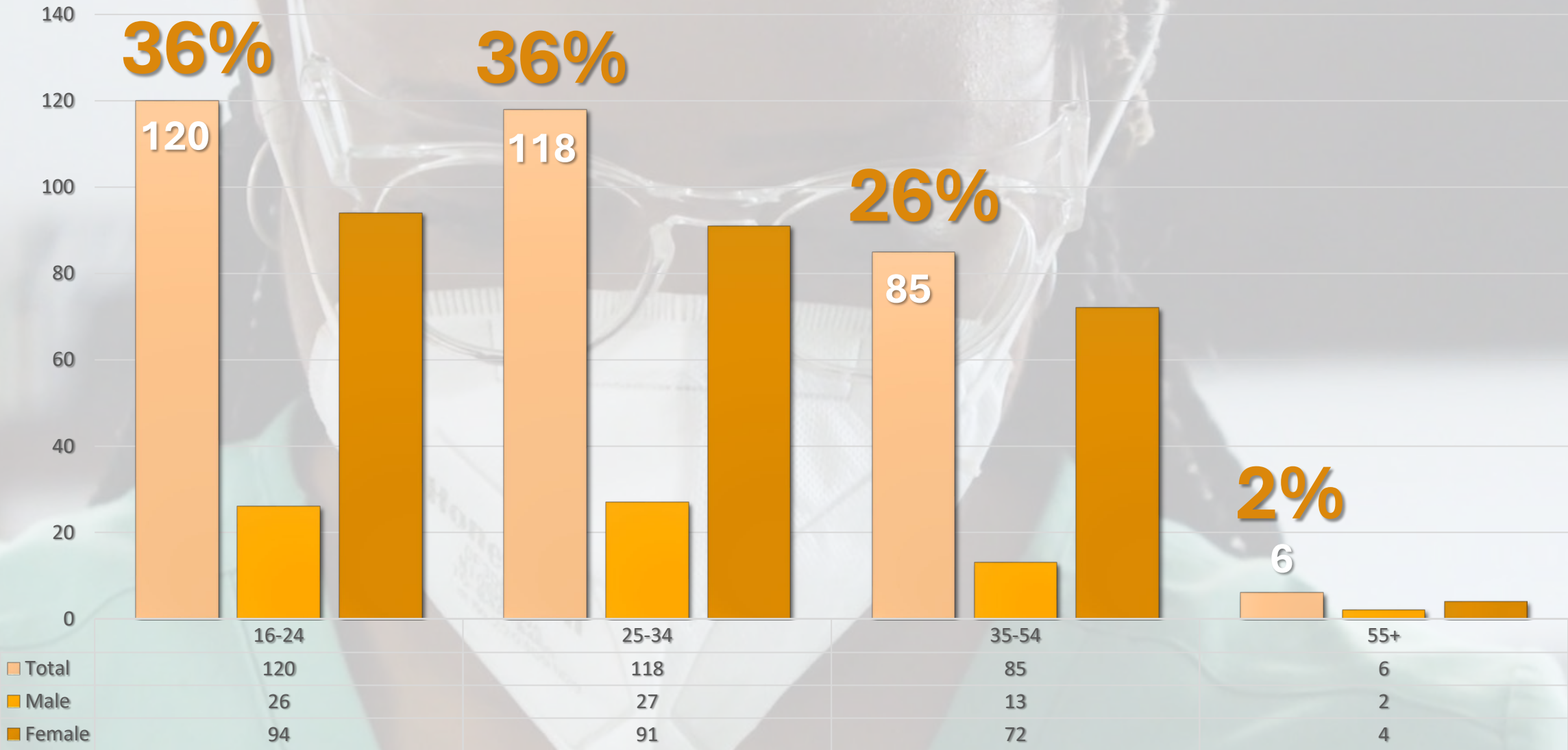

Age at Program Start – Healthcare

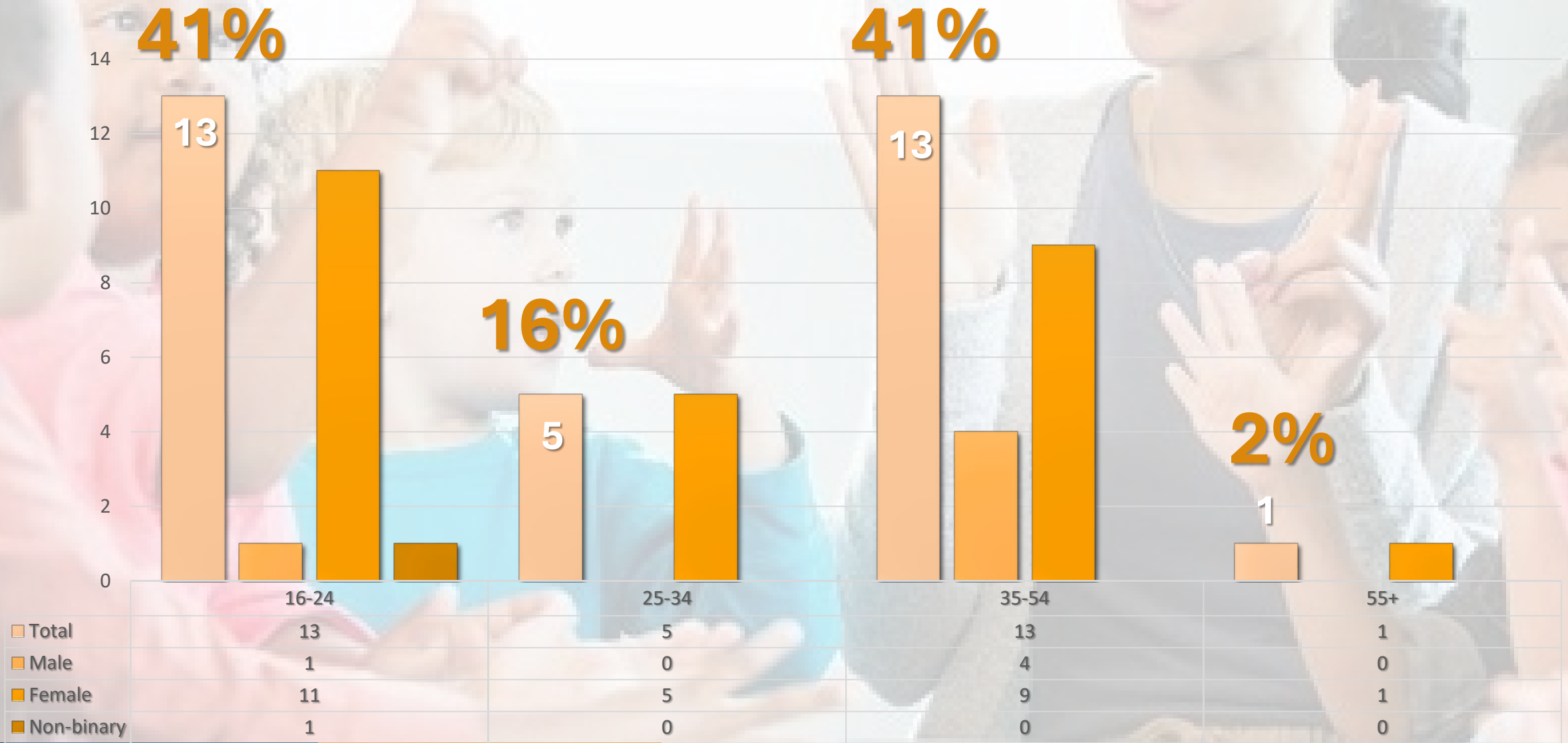

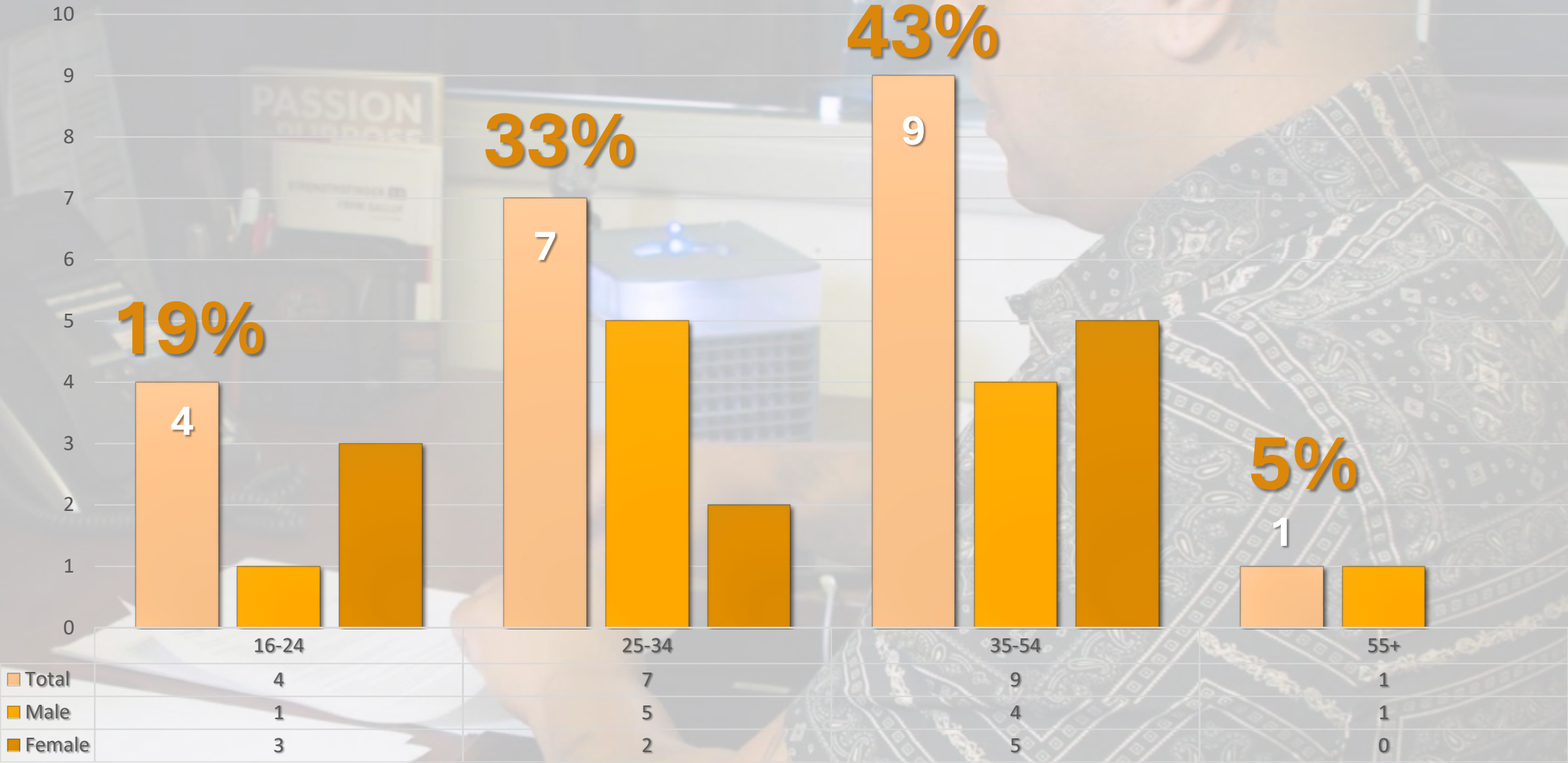
